Nominees for board member elections are still needed. We haven't heard from anyone! Please reach out if you have even an inkling of interest.



Our finances are in very good shape. We have unfortunately had to cancel our usual HOA sponsored activities for the last year, but this has also reduced some of our expenses.

Quarterly Assessment Increase

This information was provided in a special newsletter in February. There will be an increase to the quarterly assessments of \$7/quarter. This change will take effect July 1, 2021. The first and second quarter of 2021 will be charged \$157 and the third and fourth quarters of 2021 will be charged \$164. This increase is in compliance with our CC&Rs and is beginning for the 3rd quarter to allow proper notice to all members.

The annual assessment amount with the third and fourth quarter increase is \$642.00. For those who prefer to pay annually for the \$20 discount, the amount is \$622.00. Some people paid for the year based on our expecting to start the increase in the second quarter. The \$7.00 difference remains in your account and will be reflected in future statements.

The proportion of delinquent accounts remains small. Thank you, all who faithfully pay by the due date each quarter.
